Florence Nightingale Loan Box

Alongside the main objects and images, the loan box includes extra items to help bring Florence Nightingale's story to life and support a range of classroom activities.

The box includes:

- Image of the Florence Nightingale window at Romsey Abbey
- Voice recording of Florence Nightingale from 1890 (on a USB)
- Replica of The Illustrated London News article about Florence Nightingale from 1850s
- Replica of a handwritten note by Florence Nightingale (1880)
- Postcard image of Florence Nightingale's funeral and grave stone
- Dressing up costumes – bonnets and aprons
- Copy of a section of a book from 1920s referencing Embley (her childhood home)
- Glass medicine bottles

To support teaching:

- An information sheet about Florence Nightingale
- Object information cards for each item
- A simple pictorial overview to help pupils explore the collection
- Book: Little People, Big Dreams – Florence Nightingale
- Book: Florence Nightingale (Usborne)
